# POTHOLE PATROL IN WALPOLE

Anyone who drives or cycles around our ward will be dodging the potholes caused by this winter's harsh weather.

We are taking action - the worst potholes have been identified and for seven weeks "drive-through-and-fix" teams will be busy fixing them.

And there is more good news for Walpole. Over the past three years, this Conservative Council has invested a massive £18.5m in resurfacing the Borough's roads. We have already seen the benefits in Walpole, most recently in the heavily used Elers Road and Church Lane. Next year, we will continue to invest and Walpole will benefit as 10 roads are due to be resurfaced.

Councillor Ann Chapman said "Walpole's roads really need this and I'm delighted that we will be getting so many roads properly resurfaced - this is something that all residents will benefit from."
